

Zedi SilverJack Bulletin: SJ8000 Extended Shutdown Procedure

If you're planning to shut down your Zedi SilverJack 8000 (SJ8000) on a well for an extended period of time (for one day or more), follow this procedure to ensure that the equipment stays secured and undamaged.

- 1. If the Lift System is operating, stop the pump on the local controller.
- 2. Manually stroke the Lift System to the bottom of its stroke. This can be done on the local controller or on the pump.
- 3. Bleed the piston accumulator on the local controller.
- 4. Manually stroke the Lift System to the bottom of its stroke again. This makes sure that all of the Lift System's polished rods are retracted and protected from the elements.
- 5. Stop the motor on the local controller.
- 6. Shutdown the controller.



Follow this procedure if you are shutting down your SJ8000 for an extended period of time. Failure to do so may damage equipment and void warranty.
